


# How to Place HelloPush Notification Service Worker File Using **cPanel**

*This document provides clear, step-by-step instructions for implementing a service worker on your website using cPanel.*

## 1. Log in to cPanel

- Access your website's cPanel by entering your cPanel URL (e.g., <https://yourdomain.com:2083>) and logging in with your credentials.




## 2. Open the File Manager

- Navigate to the **File Manager** under the "Files" section on the cPanel dashboard.
- Go to your website's root directory (usually public\_html), where your website files are hosted.



### 3. Upload the Service Worker File

- Click the **Upload** button in the File Manager toolbar.




- Select the attached hp-service-worker.js file from your local computer and upload it to the root directory.
- Ensure the file is accessible at <https://yourdomain.com/hp-service-worker.js>. You can confirm this by typing the URL into your browser.

- Right-click the `hp-service-worker.js` file in the File Manager and select **Permissions**.
- Ensure the file has 644 permissions (readable by everyone and writable by the owner).
